\*\* To qualify as a NYIB reportable presentation, the classroom or youth activity must be conducted to a group of students or youth audience under the age of 26. Presentations are defined as a structured (formal) presentation and can be conducted in a broad range of educational settings, including a traditional classroom, scout troop meeting, church group, community group, etc. Multiple presentations to the same group of students as a continuation of a topic are counted as a single presentation (ie. JA, NEFE HSFPF, etc.) Qualifying presentations are made by credit union employees, league employees and/or credit union volunteers. All presentations are reported and recorded individually.
