

**2011 CREDIT UNION VOLUNTEER OF THE YEAR
Joseph A. Moore Lifetime Achievement Award**

AWARD CRITERIA AND NOMINATION RULES

- ◆ The Joseph A. Moore Lifetime Achievement Award has been established by the Pennsylvania Credit Union Association in memory of Joseph Moore, a former Association director and past president and Pennsylvania's first national delegate to CUNA. It is presented annually to a credit union volunteer who has selflessly given time, effort, and talent to the betterment of the movement with little or no monetary compensation.
- ◆ Nominations may be submitted by self, peer, credit union, and/or chapter board of directors.
- ◆ The nominee should be a person of good reputation in the community, a person who understands and works to promote the credit union philosophy, who has worked to better the movement, and who has demonstrated loyalty to the organized credit union movement.
- ◆ It is not necessary to obtain the nominee's prior permission, but it may be useful in verifying information and fully completing the application. Nominators are encouraged to submit testimonies and as much background information as possible about the nominee. Points are scored for each category in judging process. Note that nominee may be asked to augment or validate information submitted by third-party nomination.
- ◆ Persons who have been candidates in the past are eligible for renomination. However, it is necessary to complete and submit a fresh nomination form.
- ◆ The questionnaire must be completed in full, signed, and returned **before December 31, 2010** to: Memorial Awards, Pennsylvania Credit Union Association, 4309 North Front Street, Harrisburg, PA 17110-1618.
- ◆ The recipient of the Moore Lifetime Achievement Award will be invited to the Association Annual Convention to receive the award. Travel and lodging expenses for attending the Annual Convention will be assumed by the Association.
- ◆ Decisions of the Association Awards Committee are final. Employees of the Pennsylvania Credit Union Association and its affiliates; members of their immediate families; and current members of the Board of Directors and Awards Committee, and members of their immediate families, are ineligible for this award. Directors are eligible after leaving office.



JOSEPH A. MOORE

Volunteers are the heart of the credit union movement. Joseph Moore was passionate and committed to credit unions. A Pittsburgh firefighter, he was dedicated both professionally and personally for five decades to helping people in need. Moore helped organize the PITTSBURGH FIREMAN'S Federal Credit Union and served the credit union for 36 years.

He was a longtime board member and president of the Pittsburgh Chapter of Credit Unions and Pittsburgh Central Federal Credit Union. Moore helped organize the Pennsylvania Credit Union League (now Association) and served as a Board director from 1936 until his death in 1972. He also served as chairman of the Board for three terms.

Moore was Pennsylvania's first national delegate to the CUNA Board of Directors and served on the CUNA Board from 1936 to 1972.

In his honor, the Joseph A. Moore Lifetime Achievement Award to the Outstanding Credit Union Volunteer of the Year is presented annually by the Pennsylvania Credit Union Association.
